Parent & Spectator Behaviour

Rule 9 (a) Parent and Spectator Behaviour

It is The Clubs responsibility to undertake Codes of Conduct for parents and spectators and ensure these are adhered to, but where inappropriate behaviour is either reported to EMJFL or witnessed by EMJFL Coordinators, a zero tolerance approach to such behaviour will be enforced.

Parents must remain in the designated areas and must never enter the field of play unless invited by the referee in the case of injury. Foul and abusive language aimed at either the referee or opposition will not be tolerated and may result in you being asked to leave a venue. Aggressive or violent conduct may result in a banning order being implemented or police involvement

Rule 9 (b) Traffic Light System

The EMJFL will be operating a Club Discipline Traffic Light System. All Clubs will begin the Season in green, Clubs will be moved to amber if the League receive reports of poor or bad practice, the Club will then be informed of the report and action from said Club will be required before a Club can return to green.

Persistent bad practice or a major breach of Conduct Codes will result in a Club moving to red, at this point a Club will be given 7 days to either attend a hearing or take the appropriate action, failure to do so will result in suspension of all Club fixtures
